A player on a breakaway in the neutral or attacking zone is fouled from behind and the referee signals a penalty shot. Before the play is completed a second infraction is signalled against the same team, whether it be to the same player or a different player. The penalty shot is assessed for the first infraction (i.e. the foul from behind). Is the penalty for the second infraction still assessed? (Interpretation 2, Rule 4.11)

Correct

- ☐ Yes, if there is no goal scored on the penalty shot.
- ☒ Yes. The second penalty is always assessed.
- ☐ No. The second penalty is not assessed because it happened after the penalty shot infraction.



A player skates backwards over the blue line with the puck; that player's skates clearly enter the zone before the puck does. Is the player offside? (Rule 6.12c-i)

Correct

- ☒ The player is not offside as he had possession and control of the puck.
- ☐ The player is offside as the skates entered the zone prior to the puck.



At a stoppage of play, A14 pushes B87 who then pushes back. What penalties should be assessed? (Interpretation 1, Rule 7.9)

Correct

- ☒ Assess only A14 a penalty for "Roughing after the whistle." (Team A kills a penalty)
- ☐ Assess only B87 a penalty for "Roughing after the whistle." (Team B kills a penalty)
- ☐ Assess both players a penalty for "Roughing after the whistle." (No one kills a



penalty)

- ☐ Tell both players to stop, so long as neither continues then there is no penalty.

At 1:30 of the first period, A coach removes her team from the ice, stating "you refs are not keeping the game safe...as is my right...I am refusing to play the game." 1 minute later, an assistant coach brings the team back to the game. What penalty(s), if any, are assessed to the head coach of the the team? (Rule 10.8)
