True or false? All players must stand still for a faceoff (HC Rule 6.2a)

Correct

- False. They must be still but they may be laying on the ice.
- False. They must be standing but may be moving.
- True. All players must be standing and still prior to the puck being dropped.



In minor and female hockey, what defines a high stick when deciding to allow or disallow a puck being struck in the air? (HC Rule 6.9)

Correct

- a) the cross bar to ensure fairness for all players regardless of height.
- b) the height of the player's shoulders
- c) whether the stick is horizontal to the ice.



Goalie B and A11 are both assess minor penalties at the same stoppage. Does team B need to put a player in the box to serve the coincidental penalty? (HC Rule 4.13, note 1)

Correct

- Yes. A player from team B must serve the coincidental for the goalie
- No. There is no time penalty.
- The penalty is a minor...so no. However, if the goalie received a coincidental major penalty then a teammate would have to serve.



Under what circumstances may an injured player be on the bench? (HC Rule 2.2m)

Correct

- a) They must be wearing a neck guard, helmet and facial protection.

b) they must be listed as a player on the game sheet but do not count as rostered player

c) they must be listed as a player on the game sheet and do count as a rostered player

d) none of the above.

e) b only

f) Both A and C



A6 is fouled from behind on a break away meeting the criteria for a penalty shot. A6 is not injured. Who may take the shot? (HC Rule 4.1)

Correct

a) A6 must take the shot

b) Any team A player on the ice at the time of the infraction

c) Any team A player

d) Any team A player except a team A goalie



e) Any team A player on the ice at the time of the infraction except the goalie

The puck is in the team A's zone. Goalie A has been pulled for the extra attacker to tie the game. B7 has a clear opportunity to score on the empty net when A5 throws her stick in an attempt to disrupt the scoring chance. State referee's decision. (HC Rule 4.12a Interpretation 1)

Correct

a) Assess a penalty shot must assess a minor penalty for delay of game

b) Award team B a goal



c) Award team B a goal and assess A5 a minor penalty for interference

d) Award team B a goal so long as B7 has possession and control of the puck

e) Award team A a goal

During a battle in the corner, the referee puts a delayed penalty on when he sees A9 strike B2 with a high stick. At the stoppage, he makes the call. His liner then informs him, with A9 in the penalty box, that B2 struck himself in the face

Correct

box, that B2 struck himself in the face with his own stick. It was not A9 and there was no penalty on the play. State referee's options. (HC rule 4.15e)

- a) the player is in the box. There are no options. Keep the penalty
- b) Never change your call once it is made
- c) The referee may change his call so long as the penalty is not yet on the time clock.
- d) The referee may change his call so long as the play has not been restarted.



There is a delayed penalty against team A. Team B pulls their goalie for the extra attacker but releases their skater too early resulting in play being stopped near the team A blue line for premature substitution of the goalie. Where does the next face-off take place? (HC Rule 6.3c)

Correct

- a) at center ice for premature goalie substitution
- b) In team A's end just as with any other penalty
- c) at a face-off dot outside of team A's zone
- d) at a face-off dot of team B's blue line



What is clipping? (HC Rule 8.7)

Correct

- a) the same as a blind side hit.
- b) a player receiving a check crouches down to make contact below the knees of his opponent
